Simon will be talking to the learners about e-safety and how to keep themselves safe online. All sessions will be age appropriate and discussions will be held around different scenarios and open some fantastic discussions linked to e-safety.

With the right e-safety knowledge, learners can make the most of their online experience, giving them the potential for learning, exploring, being creative and connecting with others. However, it is paramount they also gain an understanding of safety precautions and knowing what is inappropriate or harmful behaviour or content.

We are also fortunate to be able to offer a Parent session led by Simon which will take place via zoom from 6pm-7pm on Wednesday 11th May. Content covered in this session include: Where are children and young people going online? Current risks and threats online, managing online risks and setting boundaries.
